

**Special Foster Conservation Commission Meeting**

The Foster Conservation Commission meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm; in attendance were Mike Wood, Ruth Rogers, Fran Johnson, Judy Helfgott and Ed Creighton. Marilyn Flanders and Don Manley were excused.

**Election of Officers:**
