The Foster Center Baptist Church respectfully requests addition of our building to the town's public water supply system with installation costs to be borne by the Church.

Our well is silting - in and now has a poor recovery rate. Since the well is contained within the building, any modification of it is impossible. We cannot meet state regulations with a new location; therefore we find it necessary to make this request.

A fixture in the Foster Center Historic District since 1882, we remain a vital part of our community. We have allowed public use of our parking lot by visitors to the library and to those attending the many meetings held in the Eddy building. In exchange, the Department of Public Works plows our lot at the end of a snowstorm. We are a significant supporter of the Foster Food Bank and the Department of Human Services. In addition to our religious services, over time the church has opened its facilities to organizations including Scouts, 4-H Clubs, Fostering Arts, and the Foster Preservation Society.

Our building is well maintained by an active congregation. We do not wish to become a museum; therefore, we would appreciate this consideration as we strive to maintain our very special building.
