It is ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Foster (the “Town”) that the Zoning Ordinance adopted July 1967, as last amended on August 27, 2015, (Chapter 38 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Foster Rhode Island) is hereby amended by specifically amending the text of ARTICLE IV. ZONE REGULATIONS: DESCRIPTION OF USES: SECTION 7. BUSINESS as follows:



It is further ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Foster (the “Town”) that the Zoning Ordinance adopted July 1967, as last amended on August 27, 2015, (Chapter 38 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Foster Rhode Island) is hereby amended by specifically adding a footnote to the text of ARTICLE IV. ZONE REGULATIONS: DESCRIPTION OF USES below the table in Notes as follows:

4. Drive-through uses, where permitted, shall meet the following development standards:

- a) There shall be adequate off-street parking and loading spaces to serve the proposed use. There must be sufficient on-site stacking areas to accommodate at least 10 queued vehicles, entering the site waiting to park or approach the order window/order box, and at least three queued vehicles exiting the site.
- b) Any accessory drive-through window(s) shall be properly located within the parking and circulation plan to avoid any affect on traffic, and in no case shall a drive-through window be located on any building façade which faces a public street.
- c) Vehicular entrances and exits shall be controlled by curbing.
- d) All other dimensional and parking requirements for the site and the use shall be met.
