AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF AN ORDINANCE  
ENTITLED "TOWN OF FOSTER ZONING ORDINANCES"  
ADOPTED JULY 1967 AND LAST AMENDED AUGUST 27, 2015.

It is ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Foster (the "Town") that the Zoning Ordinance adopted July 1967, as last amended on August 27, 2015, (Chapter 38 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Foster Rhode Island) is hereby amended by specifically amending the text of ARTICLE VI. SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS: SECTION 6. SEWERAGE DISPOSAL as follows:

Article VI. Supplementary Regulations

Section 6. Sewerage Disposal

A shallow surface leaching field following a septic tank shall be located at least one hundred feet (100') from a dug well or from a drilled well. No portion of the leaching field shall be closer than one hundred feet (100') to the property line except where the property borders a public road in which case the distance to the road line may be reduced to sixty feet (60').

A cesspool or seepage pit shall be located at least one hundred fifty feet (150') away from a well and at least one hundred fifty feet (150') from the property line except where the property borders a public road in which case the distance from the road line may be reduced to one hundred ten feet (110').

Any sewerage disposal system designed to leach or otherwise dispose wastes

into the soil shall be located at least two hundred feet (200') from any pond, stream, spring or brook adhere to Rhode Island General Law: Title 2 Chapter 1 Sections 18 through 28 governing the establishment of jurisdictional areas and associated setback distance to waterbodies.
